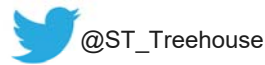

Philosophy

Spare Time Treehouse Preschool provides a fun, interactive learning experience through play based programming. The environment provides opportunities for children to explore, discover and imagine, and sparks their interest and creativity. One of our goals is school readiness developed through activities and themes such as:

- Pre-reading and pre-writing
- Learning the alphabet, numbers, shapes and colours
- Building attention spans
- Building critical thinking and decision making skills
- Building confidence and self-esteem

Guidance Philosophy

We believe that each child is unique and that their behavior is a reflection of their level of development. We follow a positive child guidance model, in which staff will model and positively reinforce appropriate behaviours.

Children are encouraged to try new things and learn from their experiences and outcomes. We teach children to express their feelings verbally and to care and respect their friends and their surroundings.
