Children entering Kindergarten (currently enrolled families only) and **Grade 1: \$275.00**
(\$220.00 for the holiday week, August 2-5)

A fee reduction has been applied for Kindergarten families (children entering K & Grade 1 in September) through the Child Care Fee Reduction Initiative (CCFRI) from the Ministry of Children and Family Development.

Children entering Grades 2-8: \$302
(\$242 for the holiday week, August 2-5)

Please note that fees are prorated on shorter weeks.
