**Children entering Kindergarten** (currently enrolled families only) and **Grade 1: \$275.00**  
**(\$220.00 for the holiday week, August 2-5)**

A fee reduction has been applied for Kindergarten families (children entering K & Grade 1 in September) through the Child Care Fee Reduction Initiative (CCFRI) from the Ministry of Children and Family Development.

**Children entering Grades 2-8: \$302**  
**(\$242 for the holiday week, August 2-5)**

*Please note in shorter weeks, fees are prorated.*

Children are encouraged to care for their own belongings. **PLEASE DO NOT BRING** money and anything that might get lost or broken.

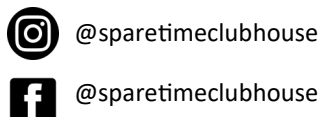
### About Us
